We introduced these guys last year but we can't help but talk about them again, the **Gambusia-affinis** (common name N.A. Mosquito Fish). The fry make great food for other fish as well and they can live over winter. Another great addition that has all the same aspects is the **Pimephales-promelas** (common name red minnow); both of these fish form loose school and their really neat to look at. I'd like to remind those of you who still don't have air **systems** the importance of having one; they really aid in the filtration water clarity and also help to grow the good bacteria. Not to mention the health of the fish.
